



his month Jerusalem will be celebrating 50 years since the reunification of the city in 1967. Jerusalem—the name reverberates throughout history! Everyone knows of this ancient city. Jerusalem was made the capital of Israel over 3,000 years ago by King David. Did you know that Jerusalem has never been the capital city of any other nation? Jerusalem has always been important to the Jewish people. Christianity was born in Jerusalem. Hundreds of years later it also became important to the Muslim faith. The city is mentioned 881 times in the Bible. Jerusalem is important to the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

In May 1948 Israel became a nation and immediately faced war. Israel won the war, but lost half of Jerusalem which was taken by the Jordanians. For the next 19 years the city was divided. Access to the holy sites, both Jewish and Christian, was limited. A no-man's land ripped a jagged scar through the center of the city. Today buildings along this seam are still marked with bullet holes that bear witness to the dangers faced during these 19 years. Then in 1967 Israel again was at war, fighting on multiple fronts, including in Jerusalem. At the end of the Six Day War, Jerusalem was once again in Israeli hands. The Jewish people rejoiced. As a Christian I am also thankful to

have free and easy access to the Old City, the site of the Temple Mount where many of the events immortalized in the Bible took place.

This month, the vibrant city will come alive with parties, dancing and laughter as her residents celebrate. Local neighborhoods as well as the city center will be full of Israelis parading through the streets. They will be wearing blue and white as they dance and sing their way to the Western Wall. They will rejoice with Jerusalem! They will rejoice that they have free access to the Western Wall, a retaining wall of the Temple—the site of constant prayer.

The Scripture Tells Us to Rejoice with Jerusalem!

"Rejoice with Jerusalem, and be glad with her, all you who love her; rejoice with joy with her, all you who mourn with her; that you may feed and be satisfied with the consolation of her bosom, that you may drink deeply and be delighted with the abundance of her glory. For thus says the LORD: 'Behold I will extend peace to her like a river, and the glory of the Gentiles like a flowing stream. Then you shall feed; on her sides shall you be carried, and be dandled on her knees. As one

whom his mother comforts, so I will comfort you; and you shall be comforted in Jerusalem" (Isa. 66:10–13 emphasis added).
