

FEAR HAS TAKEN OVER OUR WORLD.

The coronavirus is spreading rapidly throughout the world. In Israel tens of thousands of people are quarantined after traveling from countries heavily affected or

coming in contact with someone who has the virus. Some of them are infected themselves. Large gatherings are banned, causing major events like the March of the Living and the Jerusalem Marathon to be postponed until later in the year. Those at risk are told to stay away from all gatherings over 100 people, impacting synagogue and church gatherings. Travel to Israel is slowing to a trickle as tourists don't want to risk being put into quarantine for 14 days. Airlines are canceling flights. The stock market is reacting with heavy losses. It is enough to strike fear into hearts.


I am so thankful that the Lord put Psalm 91 in the Bible. The psalm starts with the words: "He who dwells in the secret place of the Most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty" (v. 1). As we read on, three times it tells us not to fear pestilence or plague:

"Surely He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler and from the perilous pestilence" (v. 3).

"...Nor the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you" (vv. 6–7).

"No evil shall befall you, nor shall any plague come near your dwelling; for He shall give His angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways" (vv. 10–11).

Many theories about the virus have surfaced, including a rabbi who says it is God judging the world and Christian Bible prophecy students asking if this is an end-time plague. Other rabbis and Christian leaders are in opposition to these theories. Go to social media, and you will find all manner of conflicting stories stirring up even more fear. Clearly fear is not from God. The apostle Paul writing to Timothy



said, "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind" (2 Tim. 1:7).

I was sitting at dinner with Israeli friends. They are traditional, not Orthodox (religious). As we talked about current events, I opened my Bible app and pulled up Psalm 91 in Hebrew. One of our designers has created a beautiful bookmark with Psalm 91 in Hebrew on one side and English on the reverse. Our team is not running away. We continue to bless the people of Israel with food, encouragement and love. Three of our team members are in quarantine presently after traveling to Europe. We are taking them food and will bring food to others who are quarantined.
